

WHAT GOD USES FOR HIS GLORY

I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses, in order that the power of Christ may dwell with me. 2 Corinthians 12:9

There's a squirrel that's been hopping around our house for a while. He caught my eye because he only has a stump of a tail. This clearly makes a difference in his movement. His jumps are shorter, less like floating, and he lands more forcefully on the ground. He's not nearly as grateful as his kin.

The squirrel doesn't know how his movement is impacted by this limitation. I have countless limitations too, or "thorns in the flesh," as Paul describes his own. I know about some of these weaknesses, and others I probably bear like the squirrel with the stumpy tail, unaware of how they impact me.

The squirrel has adapted. I can too, but I can do even more. I can give the broken, stumpy parts of me – hidden or known that seem to keep me close to the ground – and let God use them, trusting that he will for his glory.

Lord, let your power work through my weakness.

UPDATED PANDEMIC INFORMATION

Daily and Weekend Masses at St. Margaret's Church and St. Eugene's Chapel have resumed at the regular scheduled times that are posted on the front of our bulletin. However the amended restriction for all sacramental celebrations is 15% of our capacity. For <u>St. Margaret's that is 75 persons</u> and <u>St.</u> <u>Eugene's that is 30 persons</u>. This of course requires that all physical distancing and the wearing of masks must be maintained as part of the ongoing pandemic protocols.

RE-SCHEDULING CELEBRATIONS OF SACRAMENTS FROM 2020 & 2021

For all families, whose children were to celebrate sacraments in 2020 or 2021, this is to let you know that, we are starting to make plans for the **Fall of 2021** and the **Spring of 2022**.

It is **very important**, for all families concerned, to have completed a **Registration Form** for each particular sacrament, **including your email address!** Beginning in late August, we will be forwarding information to all registered families, via your email address.

NB If your child, has <u>not already completed</u> the necessary <u>registration forms</u> for: Confirmation in 2020, First Reconciliation, First Eucharist or Confirmation in 2021, you need to contact the parish office, as soon as possible, to have your email on our list, for the upcoming information.

BLESSING AT COMMUNION TIME

We would like to remind our parishioners about receiving a blessing at the Communion time of our Sunday liturgies. To indicate to the Priest, Deacon or Communion minister that you wish to receive a blessing and not the Eucharist you are instructed to cross your arms over your chest. **This is for:**



a) Children who have not received First

Eucharist.

- b) Non-Catholics
- c) Catholics who cannot receive due to an irregular marriage or other spiritual impediments.

In this case of very young children we ask that a parent hold them up before the minister.

If all who wish to receive a blessing follow this guideline it will greatly assist our Communion Ministers.

REQUEST FOR MASS INTENTIONS

When requesting Mass Intentions at the parish office, there are two types:

<u>Announced Mass</u> – a date is chosen due to availability and the name of the individual for whom the Mass is being said, along with the name of the person/family requesting the Mass is posted in the bulletin during the week of requested Mass. (*Donation \$20*)

<u>Unannounced Mass</u> – there is no specific date given for when this Mass would be celebrated and the intention does not appear in the bulletin. (*Donation* \$10)

It is important to note that when requesting any Announced Mass, it is recommended that you contact the parish office as early as possible, as sometimes we have Masses scheduled two months in advance. For both kinds of requests, Mass cards are provided at the office for those making arrangements for these special Masses.
