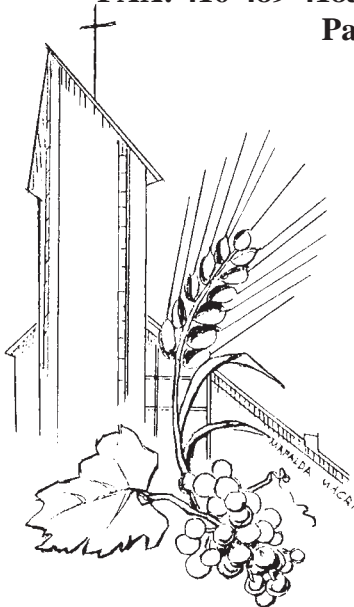

Starting Wednesday, Nov. 2nd, we will have the commemoration of all the faithful departed for the whole month of November.

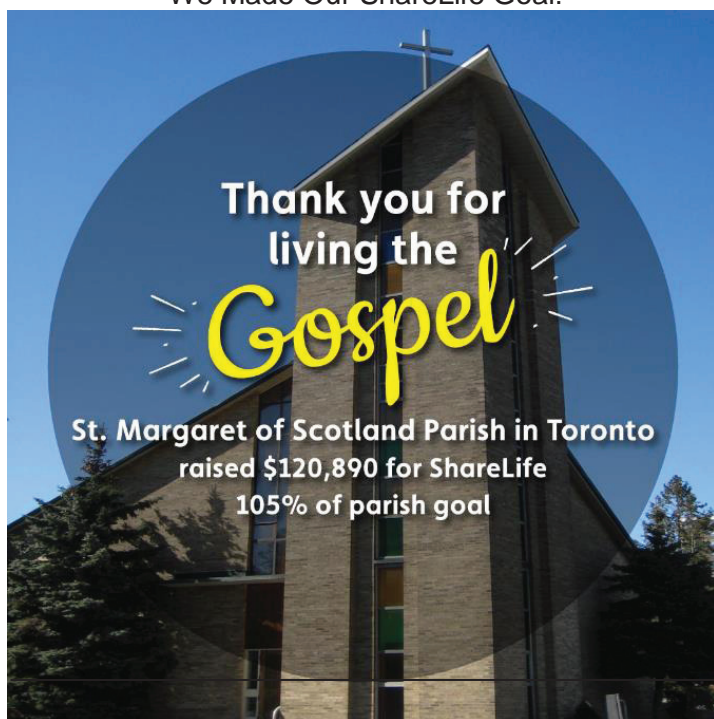
