

THE SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT de PAUL AT ST. MARGARET'S & ST. EUGENE'S

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SSVP) is a worldwide organization started 175 years ago in France by Frederic Ozanam to address the root causes of poverty and provide assistance to those in need.

St. Margaret's Parish has been serving those in need through our St. Vincent de Paul conference since 1964. Although the Society is a Catholic organization, we visit and serve anyone requesting assistance, regardless of religious beliefs or affiliations.

The SSVP at St. Margaret's/St. Eugene's parishes merged with St. Norbert's parish in 2018 and we currently have 12 volunteers.

Our main focus is home visitation and providing President's Choice gift cards to neighbours who are struggling to make ends meet. In 2022, we helped 104 households, making over 300 home visits over the year. For our members, this is the most rewarding aspect of our mission. It's an opportunity to provide a compassionate ear, emergency assistance through food vouchers, or information that will help them access appropriate services.

For this summer, we have signed up 27 girls and boys from the community for **Camp Marygrove and Camp Ozanam**. These camps are fully subsidized and provide a wonderful opportunity for children who would otherwise not be able to go to camp.

Our only fundraiser is the annual Christmas collection, which raised over \$20,000 in 2022. Along with donations through the poor box, this is used to support our neighbours in need throughout the year.

As visiting members of the Society, we are rewarded through the friendships that we develop over time with our neighbours and the ready smiles and kindnesses we receive with each visit. As with many charitable works, we often receive in spirit more than we give in aid.
