

"gaudeo," Domingo de Gaudete, Lingo ng Kagalakan, to rejoice or be glad. Gaudete Sunday occurs eight to thirteen days before Christmas, and the nearness of the feast is reason for great joy.

"Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near" (Phil 4:4-5). Advent is a time of joyful expectation and eager preparation for the Solemnity of Christmas.
