

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Anointing of the Sick should always take place in the early stages of any serious illness so that it may be received with true faith and devotion, in this way the sick as well as the family and friends may truly participate and receive real comfort from the celebration. The Sacrament should be celebrated as early as possible before there is a sense of crisis. Families should contact the parish as soon as the situation becomes serious; the sacraments for the sick should never be delayed. When death has occurred, Anointing is not celebrated or administered. The Sacraments are celebrated for the living; the dead are remembered through the prayers of the Church.
