

## **MISSION APPEAL 2024**

Deacon Rory Desmond of the Diocese of Miao will be here next weekend to make a mission appeal for the churches missionary work in India. Deacon Rory will be speaking to us about The Diocese of Miao which is in Northeast India. Miao is a new missionary church in a region bordering Tibet, China and Myanmar (Burma). The Catholic Faith has only been in this area for the last forty years and for the first fifteen years of its existence the church was underground and persecuted. This region of the Himalayas is extremely isolated and underdeveloped. The people here are a Mongolian Tribal people who are embracing the Catholic Faith eagerly and in growing numbers. Most of the population lives in scattered isolated villages. The only reliable schools, clinics and social services are those provided by the Catholic Church. The region has little, or no infrastructure or development and the Church is the only provider of reliable education and health services as well as public health projects such as clean drinking water wells. Until the Church provided schools and teachers none of the tribal people had any access to education. To see the place, people and work please have a look at the links:
