ANNUAL PARISH HEADCOUNT

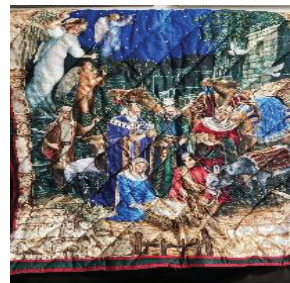
Once again, this year the Archdiocese will conduct a headcount in all parishes and mission communities this weekend and next.
