

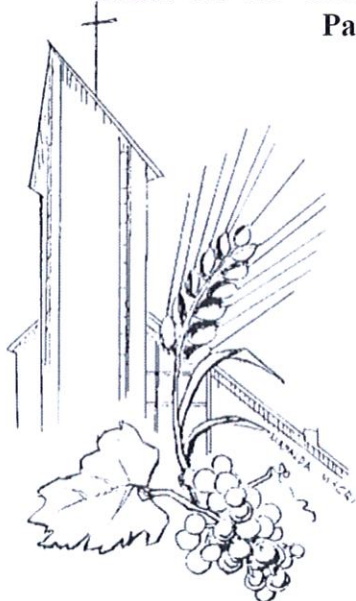

The traditional prayer for the blessing of the advent wreath from the 1st Sunday to the 4th Sunday of Advent can be found at all the entrances of the church.

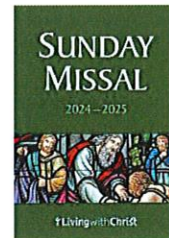

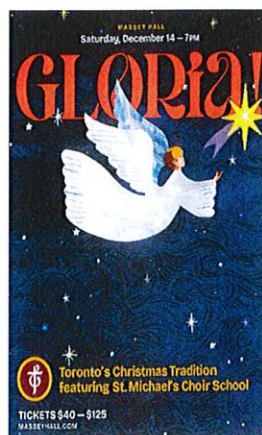

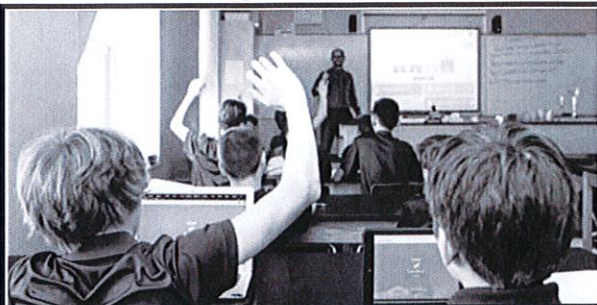
