A Universal Day of Fast and Abstinence

The law of abstinence forbids the eating of meat; the law of fasting allows one full meal a day but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning or evening, observing common sense.

The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 years and older. The law of fasting binds those from 18 – 59 years of age.

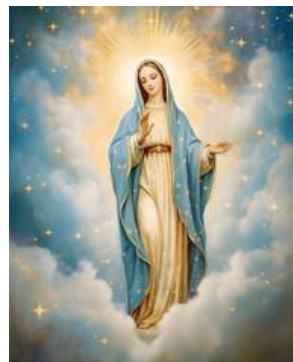
