



RCIA PROGRAM

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a program offered by Catholic parishes in Toronto for adults interested in becoming Catholic or deepening their understanding of the Catholic faith. The program typically involves a year-long process of learning, prayer, reflection, and participation in parish life, culminating in the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist). If any adults are interested in becoming Catholic or to be fully initiated to the Catholic Faith, give the Parish Office a call for more information. The program will start in the Fall.
