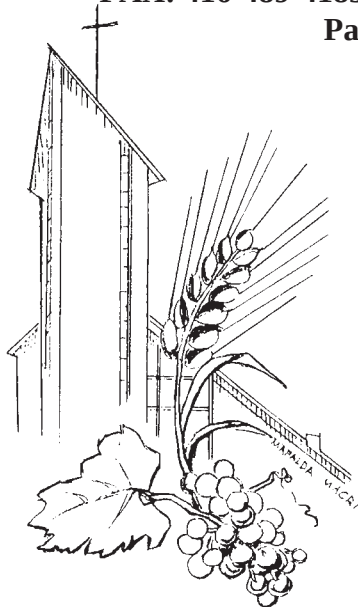

BOOK OF LIFE



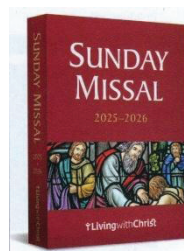

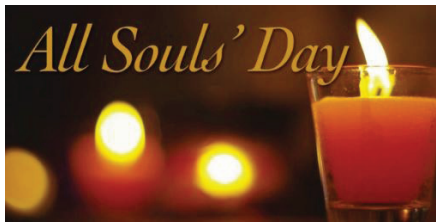
The "Book of Life" will be left in the sanctuary during November to remind us to pray, at church and at home for our loved ones.
